- 5. The attorney, as a condition of membership, pledges to support NAELA's Aspirational Standards for the Practice of Elder and Special Needs Law. The aspirational standards can be viewed at www.NAELA.org.
- 6. The attorney has knowledge of the aging network and those services available through other agencies which benefit older adults and people with disabilities, or wishes to gain such knowledge.
- 7. The attorney has a commitment to positive involvement in the work of NAELA and its purposes.
